



- Introduce yourself and share briefly about the type of team you'd like to recruit and remind them of the areas of need
- Answer any questions folks have about the team or the events
- Recruit folks for set up and tear down for all events – some daytime crews would be very helpful as well
- Recruit and/or nominate captains for Staging, Team Materials and Facility
- If needed, brainstorm and identify possible people to recruit by church; assign people present to ask them to join your team
- Brainstorm (and delegate, as much as possible) further enquiries into suppliers for staging, props, materials, chairs, tools and safety equipment, as needed

- Gain information from all attending in regard to housing, meals and transportation (will do with survey given to everyone)
- Introduce yourself and share briefly about the type of team you'd like to recruit and remind them of the areas of need (housing, meals, transportation, special events)
- Answer any questions folks have about the team or the events
- Recruit volunteers as church representatives for hospitality (to help recruit more housing or meal helpers when needed)
- Recruit help for special events coming up
- Recruit and/or nominate captains/co-captains for Meals, Special Events, Transportation and Accommodation
- Recruit folks to help contact businesses for items such as food for the teams, or maps for the welcome packs for the team members (feel free to brainstorm what you should include in packs)
- Brainstorm (free) group housing for a team (where facilities permit – showers, ample floor space or bunks, access to laundry facilities)
- Plan next meeting time

- Introduce yourself and share briefly about the type of team you'd like to recruit and remind them of the areas of need (Community-wide prayer efforts, Operation Andrew, etc)
- Gather information about existing prayer groups in churches throughout the community
- Sign people up for regular prayer updates

- Recruit volunteers to act as church representatives in the area of prayer to be a link for prayer points to their church
